PHARMACY TECHNICIAN CERTIFICATE

This certificate prepares students to work as a pharmacy technician under the supervision of a licensed pharmacist. Students will develop the skills and knowledge required of a pharmacy technician including filling prescriptions, proper storage and handling of medication, and professional customer service.

Students who complete the Pharmacy Technician Certificate can apply those courses to CCV's STEM Studies (A.S.) or Health Science (A.S.) programs.
