CCV HEALTH SCIENCE PROGRAM – IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS

The Vermont Department of Health requires CCV students who are enrolled in a health science program to provide documentation for the immunizations listed below.

- Tetanus vaccine (either Tdap or Td) within the past 10 years.
- MMR (measles, mumps, and rubella) vaccine 2 doses. You may substitute documentation of Positive Titer tests.
- **Hepatitis B** vaccine 3 doses. You may substitute documentation of Positive Titer test.
- Varicella (Chickenpox) vaccine 2 doses or positive titer test. Or, if you have had chickenpox, submit a completed Documentation of Varicella Disease form.

A medical hold stays on your account until all documentation is received but *does not* affect your ability to receive financial aid.

After you have enrolled in your health science program, you will receive an email with instructions on how to upload documentation of your immunization records.

Acceptable documentation can be supplied by any of the following: § An official record from your school, doctor's office, public health department or immunizations and the dates the immunizations and the dates the immunizations.

immunization registry listing the individual immunizations and the dates the immunizations were administered. (High schools have to keep medical records for 9 years.)

§ A laboratory report of a titer test indicating evidence of immunity to a specific disease.

If you are having trouble locating records, schedule an appointment with your primary care provider as soon as possible to assure you get the required immunizations or laboratory report. If you do not currently have a primary care provider, you can access a list of Federally Qualified Health Centers (FQHCs) in your area that provide low-cost or free immunizations: Health Centers (bistatepca.org)

Vermont allows for an exemption to the immunization vaccine requirement for medical or religious reasons. However, please keep in mind that if your health program requires an internship, you cannot get placed in an internship without the required immunization documentation.
